

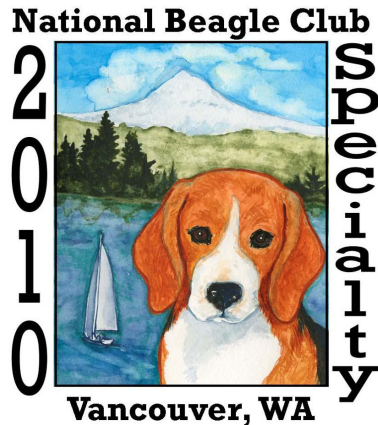

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without rules & agreement on the reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete or entries received without fees will NOT be accepted.

**Stud Dog & Brood Bitch Classes** – As the judge's decision will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Variety by virtue of having won this class. The stud dog or Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the get or produce and be entered in the show. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch need not be the owner of the get or produce. Neutered Males & Spayed Bitches may now be entered in these classes.

Stud Dog Class: For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merit of the get.

Brood Bitch Class: For bitches that have produced two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merit of the produce.

**Brace Class:** Two dogs of the same breed with identical ownership; If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated BRACE #1, BRACE #2, etc.
