- **Drawing for Entries:** A drawing will be held at Carl's Jr. Restaurant, 8140 Shelton Road, Elk Grove, CA 95758 at 6:30 pm, to determine which entries will participate in the test. If the test does not fill, there will be no meeting for the draw. Please phone (916) 216-3220 if you plan to attend the draw. Entrants are invited to attend.
- **Acknowledgements:** Notifications will be emailed and USPS mailed by the test secretary as soon as possible after the drawing of entries. - **Eligibility for entries:** Preference for entry in the TD test is for those dogs who have not yet passed an AKC TD Test. With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be a written statement (certification) dated within one (1) year and signed by a person approved by AKC to judge a Tracking Test. Preference for entry in the TDX test is for those dogs who have not yet passed an AKC TDX test. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Preference for the TD will be given in the following order of priority in accordance with AKC tracking regulations:
 - Beagle without a TD title
 - Beagle with a TD title
 - Other breeds without a TD title
 - Other breeds with a TD title
- Preference for the TDX will be given in the following order of priority in accordance with AKC tracking regulations:
 - Beagle without a TDX title
 - Beagle with a TDX title
 - Other breeds without a TDX title
 - Other breeds with a TDX title
- **Refunds:** The entry fee will be refunded if either 1) the entrant notifies the secretary prior to the draw for tracks and an alternate runs the track, or 2) the entrant declines being placed on the Alternate List, or 3) the dog is an alternate who does not run the track. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- **Alternates:** When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to Ch.1, Sec 13, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The alternates will be asked to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secre-
